

The Hungarian Educational System in General

- Compulsory from the age of 6 to 16
- Last year of kindergarten is preparation for school
- Basic education is provided by general (primary schools), originally in two cycles of four years up to the age of 14
- 1990s education system restructured wider range of opportunities to enter secondary education (at the age of 10, 12 or the traditional 14)





A: secondary school leaving certificate

B: secondary school leaving certificate and vocational qualification

C: technician qualification

D: skilled worker qualification

E: lower-level trade school qualification



Education is regulated by

the Act on Public Education the Act on Higher Education the Act on Vocational Education and the Act on Adult Education



Since the restructuring of public administration in 2010 the education sector belongs to the **Ministry of Human Resources**

Vocational and adult education are the responsibility of the **Ministry of National Economy**

New Act on Public Education

• Total transformation at the end of 2011

- Changes: legal, structural, financial
- NEW: maintenance BY THE STATE, instead of local governments

Vocational Training in Hungary

- Since 1989 new VET system faced the challenges of the market economy
- Creation of a National Vocational Qualifications Register in 1993 (renewed several times, last one 1 September 2012)
- 486 professions in 22 occupational groups
- Defines competence-based examination requirements for each qualification
- VET system was strongly school-based with few links to the labour market

Vocational Training

- The practical training is provided by organisations operating with the agreement of the chambers
- A contract of apprenticeship is concluded between a student and a firm
- The apprentices receive a payment, which amounts to at least 18% of the minimum wage in the first year
- An agreement is concluded between the school and the firm/company

NEW Vocational Training

- Sine 1st January 2013 state ownership
- **Dual system** the role of economy gets stronger
 - Chamber of Commerce
 - Practical training/internship only by the companies
- Curriculum control and content is set by the Chamber
- Financing schools do not get money directly from the companies. (goes to the state)

Vocational school

programmes

- From age 14 +
- Minimum entrance requirement 2A or 2B (ISCED level)
- No school leaving certificate
- Three-year course
- Full time education
- Qualification as skilled worker

Upper secondary vocational school

- Only from age 14 (grade 9)
- School leaving certificate
- Full time education
- 9th -12th (13) grades general subjects for school leaving exam and further studies
- vocational orientation
- theoretical and practical basic knowledge

Requiring completed upper secondary qualification of certification of maturity

- Catering manager restaurateur 2 years
- Guide 2 years
- Tourism organizing and sales 2 years
- Catering manager 1 year
- Cook 3 years (2 years after final exam)
- Confectioner 3 years (2 yrs)
- Waiter 3 years (2 yrs)



Studies for cooks, confectioners and waiters

A – B weeks

one week is school week (4+1) theoretical lessons 30% the other is practice in a realistic working environment 70 % **Subjects**:

Knowledge of economy Food knowledge Foreign language Computer studies Games/PE Vocational theory Voc. school practice Company practice Summer practice



Dual Training in Gundel

- The government wants companies to be involved and makes them interested to handle the full practical training 70%
- No competences to fulfil all the requirements:
 - Human resource
 - No professional experience in teaching
 - Means of appliances
 - Proficiency in progress

Dual Training in Gundel

Solution:

- Sharing the duties.
- Sharing financial support (1/12 goes to school)
- 10 days 6 days practice (1 day in the school)
 - 4 days theory

Company pays for:

- Working/protective clothes
- Travel expenses from outside Budapest
- Meals
- Third party insurance


Help and Support

- Annual "job fair"
- Informative meetings for employers
- Regular visits to companies providing internship
- Employers have the possibility to see the electronic register used in the school
- Professional presentations



International Programmes

- Language teaching is a priority (bilingaul classes, language preparation classes, after school studies, language examination centre)
- **Student exchange** (Holzminden, Immentstadt in Germany, Joensuu, Vantaa in Finland)
- Mobilities (Italy, France, Finland, Germany, Estonia)
- **Partnerships** (Denmark, Estonia, Finland Italy, Netherlands, Turkey, Wales,)

- Waiters: setting a gala table, serving duck breast




















Situation of Young Skilled Workers

- Unemployment rate is growing in Hungary (10.5%)
- Possibilities in the service sector great demand for courses in Hospitality and Catering
- More people are trained than needed
- 20-30% of young people go abroad (EUROPASS)
- Great fluctuation short term employment
- Still unemployment mostly because some students made a wrong choice at 14 but only about 5-8 %
